### **Service Overview**

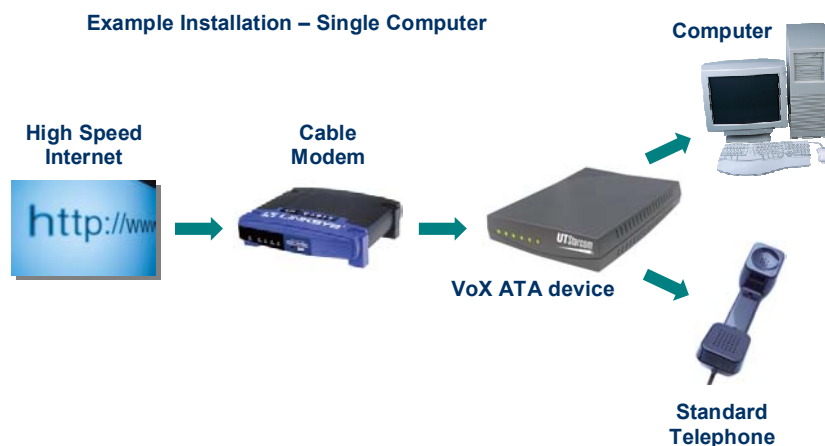

## How VoX Works

VoX uses VoIP, or Voice over Internet Protocol, which enables your customers to make and receive phone calls through the Internet. Voice is converted into packets of data, sent out over the Internet through a broadband connection, and reassembled at the other end of the line. VoX provides an adapter that is plugged in between the customer's computer and cable or DSL modem. A standard telephone is also plugged into the adapter – allowing users to place and receive calls in the same way they do today.
